Sri Lanka is a relatively small island – approximately 65,525 sq. Kilometers’ – but within its palm-fringed shores, it offers an astonishing diversity of landscapes, flora and fauna, religions and cultures. It is a land of outstanding beauty, from the verdant lowland jungles and farmland to the misty highlands, covered in places by perfectly manicured tea plantations. Day 01

Colombo / Habarana

A.M Meeting & briefing of the tour programme then proceed to Habarana.

Set in the heart of the popular cultural triangle of Sri Lanka, Minneriya National Park is mostly known for its incredible elephant migration, which is one of Asia’s finest wildlife experiences. During the drier months of June to September, as many as 300 elephants congregate in the Minneriya National Park around. This has been declared as the largest elephant gathering in the world. The ancient Minneriya water tank (which dates back to 3rd Century AD), taking advantage of the receding waters that provide an important water source.



Enjoy a afternoon safari session at Minneriya National Park. & you will go by four wheel drive & also accompanied by tracker driver.

Day 02

Am after the breakfast visit Sigiriya lion rock

Sigiriya, also known as Lion Rock, is a remarkable ancient rock fortress located in central Sri Lanka. It rises about 200 meters (660 feet) above the surrounding plains and is famous for its stunning frescoes, impressive architecture, and archaeological significance.

Built in the 5th century by King Kasyapa, Sigiriya served as both a royal citadel and a palace. The site features a massive lion's paw entrance, which is where the name "Lion Rock" comes from. Visitors can explore the remains of the palace at the summit, the beautifully painted caves, and the terraced gardens that showcase advanced ancient engineering.

Today, Sigiriya is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and attracts tourists for its breathtaking views and rich history.



After the climb you will experience the village life of Sri Lanka where you can experience authentic lifestyle of people in Sri Lanka. Which includes typical Sri Lankan cuisine lunch & cooking demo & also a farmland visits & more.

Key Highlights such as temple of tooth relic, royal botanical garden, about 132 of heritage buildings which was the main reason to declare it as a world heritage site in Sri Lanka.

Galle is a historic coastal city in southwestern Sri Lanka, known for its well-preserved colonial architecture and rich maritime history. It's a UNESCO World Heritage Site, primarily recognized for the Galle Fort, which was built by the Portuguese in the 16th century and later fortified by the Dutch & the British.
